Right after the start of the **health crisis**, the preparation of the French Presidency started

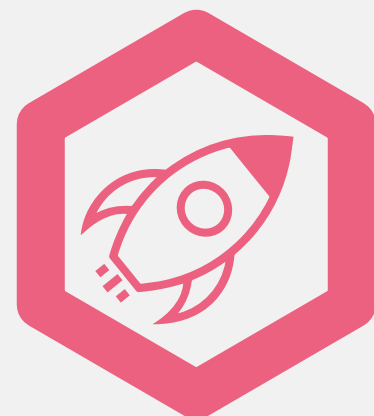


March 2022

Launch of the Presidency team (INSEE and Ministry of agriculture)



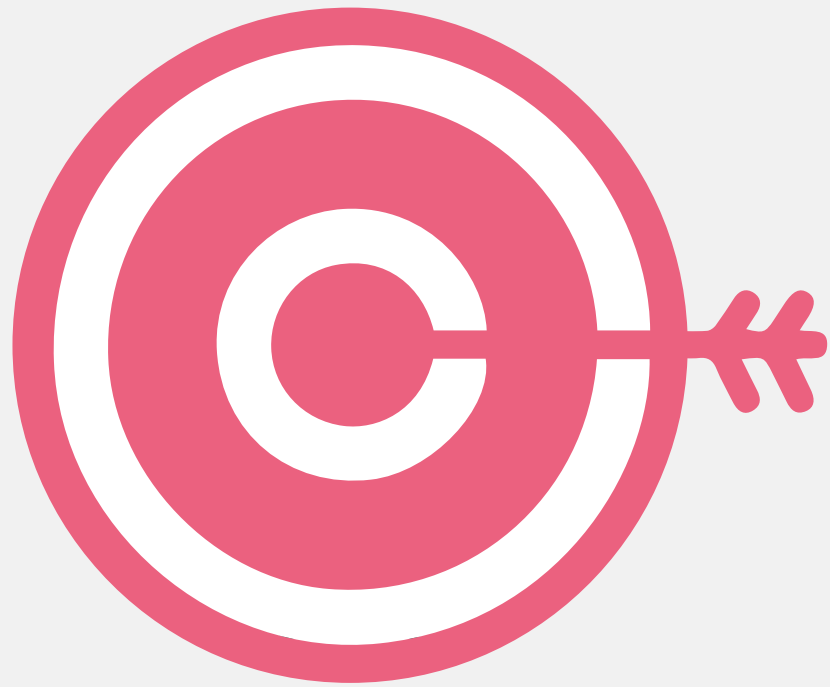

Includes derogations allowing
to use mobile phone data
for official statistics,
without user consent
