High-level meeting of the DGs of the ESS in Lyon






The 3 main objectives of the French Presidency


Reach political agreement with the European Parliament and Commission

Data Regulations and revision of 223




Follow negotiations on ePrivacy and Data Act and contribute to the Regulation 223/2009 revision process






Proposal for a Regulation on Statistics on Agricultural Input and Output (SAIO)








Proposal for a revision of Regulation (EU) No 549/2013 on the European System of Accounts (ESA2010)








Data Act: Proposal for a Regulation on harmonised rules on fair access to and use of data


